- Revenues from the sale of donated vehicles are automatically disbursed to affiliates based on the zip code of the donor, unless the donor specifies otherwise.
- Almost all vehicles are accepted, including cars, trucks, motorcycles, recreational vehicles, boats, snowmobiles, farm equipment and even construction equipment.

### Did You Know Habitat Tithes?

Over the last 25 years, Habitat Pasco has tithed **\$412,000** to North Macedonia. Your support over the years has made this partnership possible!

Tithing is a cornerstone of the Habitat for Humanity vision, as it allows us to build a WORLD where everyone has a decent place to live. Through tithing we can make a greater impact locally and globally. By taking 10% of what we have been blessed with as an affiliate and giving back to other communities in need, we also give back to God, whose love we seek to put into action. Affiliates only tithe on unrestricted donations. If a donor wishes her/his contribution to remain within our local community, none of that donation will be used in international Habitat building.

Troubled by regional conflicts and kept away from the European integration processes, North Macedonia hasn't made significant social and economic progress during the past decades. The poor quality of housing stock inherited from the period of centrally planned economy is still considered key determinant of the housing need.
